Whether compressed into one-two weeks or weekly sessions for 5-15 weeks, Comedy residencies are a must for any program. Great for any future star and self-enrichment for all, our programs go far beyond preparing students for a performance showcase at the end of the session. Students learn to work as a team, with a strong focus on respect, supporting each other, listening and eye contact. Students learn public speaking, including focus, self-confidence, projection and annunciation. Students learn creative “Out Of The Box” thinking and writing. Via journals and brainstorming exercises, students learn to free the mind of pre-judgment and fear in favor of flowing ideas of possibilities and hope. EVERY PROGRAM is customized for schedule and content according to your organization’s needs!!!

IMPROV COMEDY – Students learn a number of warm-up, technique and performance games. Live performance and storytelling are the main focus.

WRITING – Via Journals students observe and report activities in class as well as their worlds. Observations and personal experiences are the best inspirations for the young comedian.

SKETCH/STAND-UP COMEDY – Students are encouraged to take stories from Journals and develop dialogues and monologues for comedy performance. Student brainstorm elements of story, 5-senses and other observations.

LIVE PERFORMANCE – Students finish Residency with a performance of Improv Games and Selected Sketches/Stand-Up routines. Top students have been invited to perform at out NYC public shows.

VIDEO ARCHIVE – SGF PRODUCTIONS will record final performance and present to organization for archive. Professionals record every show and learn from successes and mistakes. Fun for memories of experience and invaluable learning tool for future growth.
